Introduction

The National Museum of African American History and Culture (NMAAHC) opened its doors to the public in September of 2016. Since then, it has served as the only national museum dedicated exclusively to the documentation of African American life, history, and culture. While only a few hours away from Charlottesville, the NMAAHC is still inaccessible to many students at the University of Virginia. The Eta Sigma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. seeks to address this issue by giving a group of UVA students the chance to experience *The Dayz of Wayback*.

Logistics

- The Brothers of Eta Sigma have secured a limited number of tickets for the museum for Sunday, March 25th and a charter bus to transport all ticketholders from UVA to the museum and back.
- The bus will depart from UVA at **11:00 AM on Sunday, March 25th and return to UVA by 8:30 PM** on the same day.
